- 1. Where are the posters displayed?**
Posters are displayed in the exhibit hall.
- 2. When can I set up my poster?**
All posters must be displayed on a board no later than 9:00 AM on Saturday, June 23.
- 3. What will my poster be displayed on?**
Posters will be displayed on 4' by 8' fabric bulletin boards. Please bring your own tacks to hang your poster.
- 4. Who will tabulate the judged forms?**
Randomly selected Members of the MAFP Board and Education Commission.
- 5. When will the poster winners be announced?**
Awards for top posters will be presented during the social mixer from 2:30-4:00 PM on Saturday, June 23.
- 6. What type of criteria will my poster be judged on?**
The poster review form will consist of five categories rated on a scale of 1 to 5, with 5 being the highest.
 - **ORIGINALITY:** How original is the concept presented in this poster? Or, how original is the new approach to an old problem?
 - **SIGNIFICANCE:** How significant are the poster's conclusions in increasing understanding of a disease process, or in improving the diagnosis or treatment of a disease state or in improving quality or efficiency?
 - **PRESENTATION:** How logical are the ideas presented in this poster? How interesting is the manner of presentation? How clearly written and free of significant grammatical errors is its abstract?
 - **METHODS:** If applicable, how suitable is the research design for the stated objectives, and how appropriate are any statistical techniques applied?
 - **VISUAL IMPACT:** How effective is this poster visually? How valuable is each figure and graph in furthering viewers' understanding of the research subject?
- 7. What happens if my poster is not posted by Saturday, June 23 at 9:00 AM?**
If a poster is not displayed by this time, it will not be judged.
