RESIDENT/STUDENT POSTER SESSION AND PRESENTATIONS

MAFP 70TH SHOW ME FAMILY MEDICINE CONFERENCE (FORMERLY THE ANNUAL SCIENTIFIC ASSEMBLY) June 8-9, 2018

Resident and Student Attendees of the 2018 Missouri Academy of Family Physicians Show Me Family Medicine Conference, (formerly the Annual Scientific Assembly) are invited to participate in this meeting by **displaying or presenting** a poster highlighting patient quality improvement projects, scientific research programs, patient safety, clinical vignettes, clinical research, or other projects related to family medicine. Participants are invited to exhibit work still in progress, innovations recently introduced, or established projects. Posters will be arranged in an exhibit area on display for all attendees. New this year, there will be two competitions, one will focus on case studies, and the other will focus on research.

POSTER DISPLAYS

Posters will be displayed on 4' by 8' fabric bulletin boards. All posters must be displayed on a board <u>no later than 9:00 am on Friday, June 8, 2018</u>. If a poster is not displayed by this time, it will not be judged. Randomly selected members of the Missouri Academy of Family Physicians Education Commission and Board of Directors will judge all poster submissions on Friday. Awards for top posters will be presented during the Reception from 5:15-6:15 pm on Friday. You do not need to be present to win.

Please use the following criteria when creating your poster:

CASE STUDY

- 1. Family medicine oriented
- 2. Original and/or innovative
- 3. Inquiry question based on the patient case
- 4. Was the type of study described?
- 5. Clarity of purpose and goals of study
- 6. Organization of study

RESEARCH

- 1. Patient Oriented
- 2. Original/Innovative nature of project
- 3. How suitable is the research design for the stated objectives, and how appropriate are any statistical techniques applied?
- 4. Was the type of study described?
- 5. Clarity of purpose and goals of study
- 6. Organization of study

Both classes of posters will be judged on:

- 1. **SIGNIFICANCE:** How significant are the poster's conclusions in increasing understanding of a disease process, or in improving the diagnosis or treatment of a disease state or in improving quality or efficiency?
- 2. **PRESENTATION:** How logical are the ideas presented in this poster? How interesting is the manner of presentation? Is the abstract clearly written and free of significant grammatical errors?
- 3. **VISUAL IMPACT:** How effective is this poster visually? How valuable is each figure and graph in furthering viewers' understanding of the research subject?

POSTER PRESENTATION

Family Medicine Residents and Students are asked to present a 15-minute poster presentation during Show Me Family Medicine Conference, (formerly the Annual Scientific Assembly), on Saturday, June 9, 2018, 3:45 – 4:45 p.m. at the Lodge at Old Kinderhook, Camdenton, Missouri. Those selected to make a presentation will receive one night's complimentary lodging, complimentary conference registration, and mileage to/from the conference. Most importantly, you will be given the opportunity to share your case study or research project to colleagues. This scholarly activity shows your commitment to family medicine.
