November 19, 2021 - Heafner Named MAFP Outstanding Resident of the Year

The Missouri Academy of Family Physicians (MAFP) presented John Heafner, MD, MPH, of St. Louis, Missouri, with the 2021 Outstanding Resident of the Year Award at the Academy's 73rd Annual Meeting held November 12-13, 2021 at Big Cedar Lodge, Ridgedale, Missouri. Dr. Heafner was chosen as the award recipient by a committee of family physicians from nominations made by Missouri family medicine residency programs.

The MAFP Outstanding Resident of the Year award is presented to a graduating Missouri resident who exhibits exemplary patient care, demonstrates leadership, displays a commitment to the community, contributes to scholarly activity and is dedicated to the specialty of Family Medicine. The recipient of this award, Dr. John Heafner, has served on the board of the Missouri Academy of Family Physicians and the American Academy of Family Physicians. Dr. John Heafner completed medical school and residency at Saint Louis University, and is now employed with Family Care Health Center in St. Louis.
