STRATEGIC PLAN

The Executive Board met in March for a strategic planning session, to review the SLAFP mission statement and to discuss areas of focus moving forward. We reviewed last year's member survey, discussed the organizations' areas of strength, and listed potential areas for improvement. Three areas of focus were identified at the conclusion of the session:

- 1) Member engagement through improved communication and volunteer opportunities
- 2) Outreach and community building for our members
- 3) Support for local medical students interested in Family Medicine, and for current Family Medicine residents

We have used these areas of focus to guide our work thus far in 2023.
